EVAATF Multidisciplinary Team (MDT) Case Review Criteria

The following types of cases must be presented to the team. Other cases that present significant concerns may also be presented for MDT case review.

Physical Abuse:

- Reported cases where hospitalization or medical treatment is needed.
- Multi-victim physical abuse cases
- Prior history of violence perpetrated by suspect.
- Maltreatment in an out-of-home facility.
- Injuries to genitalia, head, abdomen, or multiple injuries.
- The use of objects to cause significant injuries.
- Domestic Violence cases.

Sexual Abuse:

- Any case of reported sexual abuse of a vulnerable adult.

Neglect:

- Reported neglect that leads to hospitalization or physical injury.
- Prior history of reported neglect.

Financial Exploitation:

- Any financial exploitation that also has elements of neglect, physical abuse, or sexual abuse.
